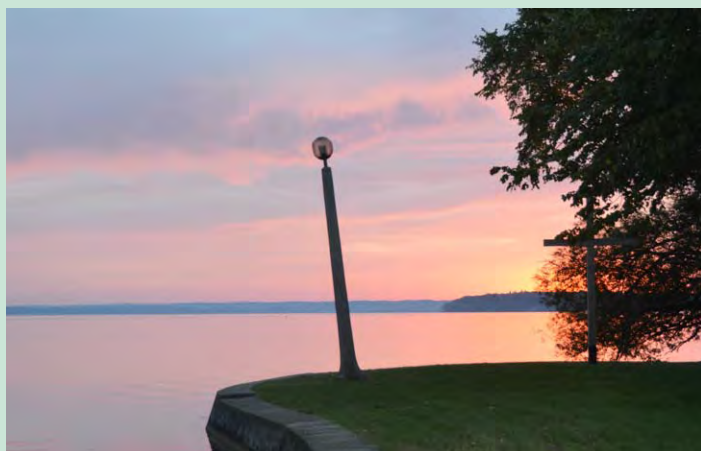

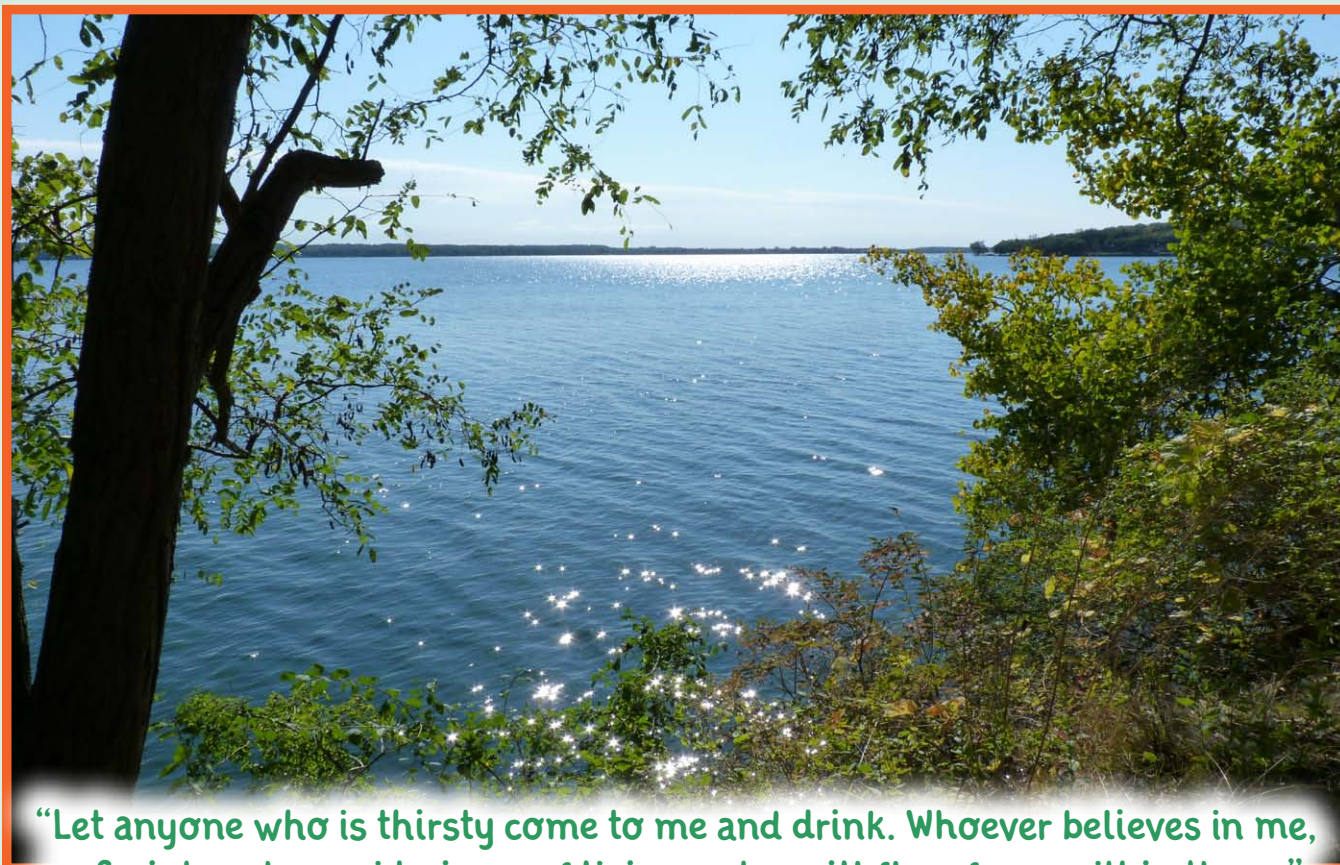

We are literally addressing water issues now. Our water tower failed, and we are installing a new stainless steel tank. The original Lawson-era tank lasted over 80 years inside Judson Tower and the new one is designed to have an even longer lifespan. We are renovating hotel rooms at Roger Williams Inn and Lawson Lodge, maximizing lake views with window treatments so guests can gaze out at God's artwork seen in sunrises and eagles flying above the shimmering waters of Green Lake. We are hiring an additional student staff director and more student staff to grow our program. This will nurture and train young Christian leaders as they make memories and relationships that will last a lifetime.

We ask you to continue to pray for our staff as we create the opportunity for conferees to experience -- whether for the first time or in new and fresh ways -- a closer walk with God in Christ, the Living Water! We also ask you to consider making a gift to Green Lake as we partner together to nurture and train leaders for greater impact in their spheres of influence as they lead others more effectively to the Living Water.
